Dear Parents/Carers,

We will continue to keep you updated in regards to the Coronavirus guidance. As you are aware there continues to be no directive for schools to close at this time.

The latest Government guidelines as announced yesterday are:

- **If any member of a family shows symptoms the advice is that the whole household should self-isolate for 14 days. This is to help to protect others in the community.**
- Women who are pregnant have been advised to avoid social contact where possible.
- An announcement about self-isolation for particular groups of people is expected later this week; these groups include:
 - Those who are pregnant
 - Have serious underlying health conditions
 - Are aged over 70.
- **Schools are to stay open**

We will work on a daily basis with a business as usual approach but we will keep parents fully updated of any adaptations we may have to make due to the impact of self-isolation guidance. Our text messaging and email services will be used to inform you of any updates with us much notice as possible.

If you have any concerns in regards to your child's health; NHS 111 have an online advice system where you can provide specific details of your concerns. As a school we cannot advise you on your child's symptoms and the subsequent actions; NHS 111 guidance should be followed. Please do not phone them unless it is an emergency.

We do insist that you follow the government guidance and NHS 111 advice on this matter. If a child shows any of the symptoms in school we will call you to collect them.

As a school we are cancelling any school visitors during this time.

Your support in this matter is greatly appreciated and as always we are committed to the education, health and wellbeing of your children.
